Newsletter – Marie Kirzl reported that articles are due the 1st of December and if you can get them in sooner that would be great.

For the Committee reports President Ann Davis only called on the committees who had things to report.

Community Service – Kathy Denneler forgot to bring the items to put in the treasurer boxes, but she will fill them and get them to Ann Davis for

distribution. Ann Davis will make arrangements with the Hermitage to deliver their painted gifts. Amanda Davis reported that she has heads for the cure to be painted and she is trying to get a contact at Bethesda and Walter Reed Hospitals so that we can deliver to them also. Right now the heads we paint go to Fort Belvoir.

Founder's Medallion – Peg Altemus reported that if you have someone you still want to nominate please get the nominations to her either later today or tomorrow.

Nominating – Fran Schmitt reported that we do have a full slate.

Public Relations Maryland – Ann Davis stated that Brookside Gardens would like us to paint gourds again this next year for their fund raiser. We may do it. Kathy Denneler stated she has gourds, but they need to be cleaned.

Public Relations Virginia – Lorraine Lasch reported that we have a display at the Montclair Community Library for the end of October through November. Pictures were taken and sent to John Kirzl for the newsletter.

Seminar – Ann Davis stated they are still looking for a teacher. If we have a seminar, it will be sometime in the fall.

Sunshine – Barbara Gloeckner asked how Kay was doing and Ann Davis reported that we was doing better.

Old Business: Reminder we will only have pot luck at the January and November meetings.

The Holiday Inn in Sterling, VA would like us to put down a deposit for our 2018 luncheon. After some discussion, Ann Gibbons made a motion that we do not put down a deposit at this time. Kathy Denneler seconded. Motion passed.

Instructions

DecoArt Americana Acrylics (provided): Antique Maroon, Blue Harbor, Fawn, Foliage Green, French Vanilla, Hauser Medium Green, Lamp Black, Lemonade, Snow White, Terra Coral, Uniform Blue

Suggested Brushes: Liner, Small dry brush, #2 filbert, ¼" angle shader

Optional: Black Ultra Fine Sharpie

Surface of your choice (Example came from Viking Woodcrafts. Cabin Crafters also has tags).

Prep instructions: Seal and sand surface. Basecoat with Lamp Black. Spatter with Snow White. Transfer the rectangle designs. Basecoat the top rectangle with Blue Harbor and the bottom rectangle with Foliage Green. If you're using scotch tape to keep sharp, straight lines, use a craft knife and a ruler to lightly cut through and remove the tape on inside corners or edges.

Transfer the rest of the design. I transferred the top 2/3 items first, which are the items in the blue and green boxes. Then I moved the tracing paper up a smidge to transfer the bottom part of the design to ensure that I could see it when the tag is in the holder. Basecoat the word "Welcome" with Lamp Black and "Spring" with Blue Harbor.
