Ann Foster was a Founding Mother of the NCC and passed away on October 10, 2017. The following is her obituary and a note of remembrance from Sandy Scales

Ann Wynn (Whitacre) Foster, 79, formerly of Warrensburg NY, passed away peacefully, Tuesday, October 10, 2017, in St. Augustine, Florida.

Born July 20, 1938 in New York, New York, she was the daughter of the late Evan and Egrynwen (Richards) Whitacre.

Ann graduated from Warrensburg High School, Class of 1956, and Mary Hitchcock School of Nursing in 1958. As the wife of an Army officer, Ann traveled throughout the United States and many countries in Europe while raising her family. She was actively involved in Girl Scouts while living in Germany and the United States. Ann was an avid Tole and Decorative painter, and developed a talent and enthusiasm for teaching the Art for more than 30 years. Her passion and accomplishments in Decorative Art included organizing and beginning Chapters in several states for the National Society for Tole and Decorative Painters.

In addition to her parents, Ann is predeceased by her brother, Evan Buzby Whitacre.

She is survived by her sister, Peggy (Strutton); three children, Jeffrey, Karen and Jamie; nine grandchildren; and three great grandchildren.

I was deeply saddened to learn that one of our founding mothers, Ann Foster, passed away last week.

Ann was one of five incredible ladies who founded our chapter in 1976. I didn't know her at that time but met her shortly after I moved to the area in 1989 through numerous seminars we both took from Betty Caithness. She was an avid Tole and Decorative painter, and developed a talent and enthusiasm for teaching the Art for more than 30 years. Her passion and accomplishments in Decorative Art included organizing and beginning Chapters in several states for the SDP. Ann and I roomed together for years at many SDP Conventions across the country. She opened up her home to me in Jacksonville, FL on many occasions when I taught painting seminars at her local chapter. Each time that she made the trip north to visit her daughter, Karen and family, in Centreville, VA, she would always call before she got on the road to let me know that she was headed north so that we could plan for lunch during her visit in Virginia. In between conventions and my visits to Florida, we always kept in touch. I will never forget her smile and laughter. She was a remarkable lady who will forever be in my heart.
