September 17, 2016

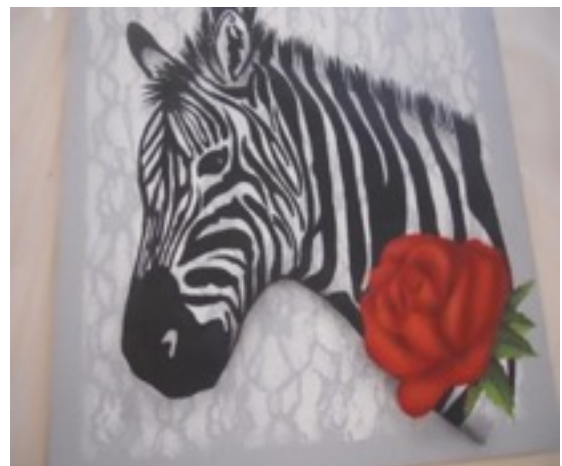
